Why do I need an apprentice leader?

Apprentice development utilizes the principle of multiplication. For example, an effective evangelist who reaching 1,000 people a day for Christ will win the world to Christ in 13,515 years. But a very effective discipler who teaches or trains two people a year to reach others for Christ has the potential to win the world to Christ in 33 years.
