Phillip's Internship Plan

Purpose: To provide Phillip with the training necessary to be an effective servant of Christ both in his personal life and in the lives of Junior High and Senior High students.

Duration: This internship begins June 14, 2005 and runs through May 23, 2006, at which time we will evaluate the internship based on the accomplishment of its goals. The internship plan will then be revised and new internship goals will be formed.

Goals: In partnership with Tim, Phillip will be coached in the following areas:

- To experience personal spiritual growth
- To accurately handle scripture
- To creatively communicate scripture
- To develop a personal philosophy of youth ministry
- To use the resources at Redeemer Covenant Church for implementing that philosophy

Implementation Strategy for June 21-August 23: In order to accomplish our goals, Phillip and Tim will meet one-on-one every Tuesday at lunch time. The following is a flexible agenda for those meetings:

- Time in prayer for each other and the youth ministry (15 minutes)
- Discuss *Purpose Driven Youth Ministry* readings (15 minutes)
- Discuss *Living by the Book* readings (15 minutes)
- Review youth ministry assignments, i.e. John 6:22-29 lesson plan, programming, relationships with students, games, etc. (15 minutes)
